Dr. Sheila Liewald, DACM, L.Ac. earned her Master of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine degree from the SouthWest Acupuncture College in Boulder, CO. This four-year program consists of over 3,000 hours of education including over 1,000 hours of clinical practice. She is certified with a license in Acupuncture and Traditional Chinese Medicine by the National Certification Commission for Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine (NCCAOM) as of August 2006. This also includes certification in Clean Needle Technique and internships.

In 2018 she went on to pursue her doctorate in acupuncture and Chinese medicine with Pacific College of Oriental Medicine in San Diego CA.

In addition to acupuncture training, adjunctive therapies include moxibustion, tui-na, acupressure, cupping, auriculotherapy, E-stim, Chinese herbs and homeopathy. Sheila also did continuing education through the Kairos Institute in New Mexico for sound healing.

Dr. Liewald is a member of the Acupuncture Association of Colorado and American Association of Oriental Medicine. She is a registered acupuncturist with Colorado state. This license, the certifications, or registrations has never been suspended or revoked.

This clinic complies with the Colorado State Department of Health, including the proper use of needles and the sanitation of acupuncture offices. Only single-use, disposable, factory-sealed needles are utilized.
